### Agenda Approved

- Principal's Report – Mellissa Ryan
  - Jagzone up and running
    - Teachers can show the videos to their classroom at any time
    - COVID safety reminders are usually included in the Jagzone videos
  - Grade 5 public health unit visits
  - In school immunizations for grade 6 is a go this spring. The middle school gym will be used
  - Elementary Jump rope for heart will happen this year
    - Looking at COVID safe ways to run it
  - Playground is under construction and will be complete after spring break
  - Looking for adult sock donations for a sock drive.

  - Emergency prep – water jugs need to be moved somewhere not in the school “cage”
